CLOVIS REGNIER OF ST. LOUIS. CURRENTLY THE AREA DIRECTOR FOR WESTERN REGION 2 OF THE METIS SOCIETY OF SASKATCHEWAN, MR. REGNIER IS NOTED FOR HIS ANCESTRAL ASSOCIATION WITH BATOCHE, AND FOR HIS WORK AS AN EARLY POLITICAL ORGANIZER OF THE METIS.
