


Heart Butte, North Dakota:

Heart Butte, also called Mni Wakan Cante (Heart of the Sacred Water) by the Dakota is located eight miles south-east of Fort Totten on the south shore of Devil's Lake. In 1868, Father Genin set a large wooden cross on top of Heart Butte and held a mass for 500 Metis and 900 Dakota.



Devil's Heart Butte: Devils Heart Butte is a mountain summit in Benson County SE of Fort Totten in the state of North Dakota. Devils Heart Butte climbs to 1,657 feet (505.05 meters) above sea level. Devils Heart Butte is located at latitude - longitude coordinates (also called lat - long coordinates or GPS coordinates) of N 47.933888 and W - 98.857337.
