

## HISTORY: MACSI 25-Year Overview

1969 The Metis Addictions Council of Saskatchewan Incorporated (M.A.C.S.I.) was established in 1969 to provide rehabilitation, education and prevention services to all Aboriginal people seeking help for drug and alcohol abuse. The following are excerpts from an historical report prepared by M.A.C.S.I.:

"Early in 1969, a group of concerned native people approached the Federal and Provincial governments to hold a conference on native alcoholism."

"A three day conference was set up November 1969. A total of 200 delegates attended this conference. They represented all the southern reserves and southern Metis communities. From this conference a board of directors were elected."

The board of directors included Walter Stonechild, Walter Gordon, Ted Keewatin, Frank Richard, Arnold Dufour, and Isabel Keewatin. The organization formed was called the Native Alcoholism Council (NAC). The organization was to serve both status Indians and Metis. The task of the board was to develop a program and seek funding for that program.

1970 A second conference to obtain the support and involvement of northern reserves and northern Metis was held in Prince Albert in May 1970. This second conference supported the decisions of the first conference.

1971 A field educator program was developed and a start-up grant of \$110,000 was received from the Doimer Foundation in late 1970. At this time government funding was not obtained. The Donner Foundation grant covered 6 field staff plus administration. In 1971, agreements for funding of alcohol treatment for native people were reached with provincial Social Services and federal Indian Affairs for a per diem rate of \$6.00. This amount did not pay for staff so an additional grant was received from Canada Manpower under the Local Initiatives Program (LIP) which funded 34 positions at about \$400.00 per month.

With these funding arrangements in place, two in-patient treatment centres referred to as "Social Adjustment Centres" were started. These two centres were located in North Battleford and in Prince Albert. The LIP grant provided 8 positions for each of these centres. The remainder of the LIP positions operated as field educators making a total of 24 field educators.

In 1971, the Donner Foundation start-up grant came to an end. It was necessary to find a more permanent method of funding for the administration area and the field educators. Negotiations were undertaken with Saskatchewan Health, which agreed to support NAC if the two major native organizations (The Federation of Saskatchewan Indians and the Metis Society) agreed to support NAC. A tentative agreement was reached with a funding level of \$250,000 per year. Just prior to the signing of the agreement, the FSI decided that they could more effectively deal with the on-reserve alcoholism in a different way so they withdrew their support. The agreement was no longer viable and the Donner Foundation grant was exhausted.

NAC then turned to the Metis Society and requested support and assistance. The Metis Society agreed to cover the existing deficit (about \$20,000) if NAC became a program of the Metis Society. The final meeting of the NAC board was held on December 1, 1971 and the following motion was passed:

"I move that under the circumstances that the NAC board dissolve; and become a program committee under the direction of the Metis Society of Saskatchewan and to continue alcoholism and drug service to all native people effective January 1, 1972."

An agreement was then negotiated with Saskatchewan Health to fund the alcohol treatment program at a level of \$125,000.00 per year for the core program.
