

Gariepy, François Sr. (1797-1851)

François Gariepy was the son of Jean Baptiste Gariepy and Thérèse Moreau. He died on May 6, 1851 in North Dakota. In 1824, he was married to Louise Gladu, born 1806 at Pembina, N.D. and died on February 14, 1855, at Pembina. Louise Josephte Elise Gladu was the Métis daughter of Charles Gladu (b. 1877) and Marguerite Ross. This family was a member of the Turtle Mountain Band. Their children were:

- François, born c. 1824, he married Helene Poitras.
- Pierre was born in 1826. On September 10, 1848 he married Marie Rose Grant at St. François Xavier.
- Andre was born in 1832 at St. Paul and died on April 28, 1850 in Pembina.
- Marie Anne was born circa 1834 at St. François Xavier. She married Joseph Delorme (b. 1831), the son of François Henault dit Delorme and Charlotte (Chippewa or Saulteaux).
- Jean Baptiste, was born in 1835 at St. François Xavier. He received Métis scrip under the Red Lake and Pembina Treaty. Jean Baptiste married Marie Fagnant and then Helene Beardy.
- La Louise, was born in 1836 and died on January 17, 1884 in Lebret. She married Alexandre Wilkie (b. 1831). Her second marriage was to Pierre Bonneau (b. 1803) in 1828 at St. François Xavier.
- Philippe Elzear, was born on August 11, 1839 at St. François Xavier. He married Rosalie Parenteau.
