


## Métis Winterers at St. Laurent on the South Saskatchewan

Shown below is a four page census document listing the Métis wintering near Fort Carlton in 1871. These people are the founders of what became St. Laurent and Batoche Saskatchewan. Many of these Métis buffalo hunters later participated in the Northwest Resistance of 1885, fourteen years after this census was taken.

The document is from the Richard C. Hardisty Fonds of the Glenbow Institute: Document M-477-150 — An Enumeration of the French Métis population at mission at St. Laurent, by Lawrence Clarke, Carlton House. — December 31, 1871

Note Lawrence Clarke's final comment that the annual income for each of these hunters was between £100 and £500 Sterling.
