

# Bringing Métis Children's Literature to Life—Entertainment Stories (To be done after reading *Sasquatch Exterminator*, *The Beavers' Big House*, and *Roogaroo Mickey*)

\*For this project use the *Stories of Our People: A Métis Graphic Novel Anthology*. This anthology has a variety of stories appropriate for different age levels. The Trickster stories are not as dark as the Whittigo or Paakuk stories. Choose an appropriate story for the age group you are teaching. ## Project:

- Take one of the unillustrated story sections of the graphic novel and divide it into portions. Give one portion to each student.
- Have students illustrate their portion with tissue collage and silhouettes.
- Video each person reading their portion while you capture their illustrated version of that caption.
- Piece together all of the captions for a complete story. Show it to the school at an assembly or to parents on a parent night.
