
To each of the three members of the Electoral Commission, please accept this letter as an official written recommendation concerning the ballot configuration.

In order to ensure a fair and democratic process in the upcoming election, I would suggest the following:

- 1) That all ballots be printed with a serial number
- 2) That just prior to disbursement to all polling stations that ballots be marked on the back with an official stamp perhaps stating " Campaign ' 98 " or such other words chosen secret by the Electoral Committee. Upon Completion, The stamp to be destroyed.
- 3) In addition to the stamp, all ballots should be initialed by the Electoral officer before being distributed to the polling stations.
- 4) That at the time of counting the ballots, the returning officer (Earl Pelletier) shall discard any ballots that did not meet the specified configurations.

By having a process, such as the above recommendation, any late concerns raised about the integrity of the process can be easily and efficiently dealt with.
