DEAR SIR:

THE SOUTH EAST AREA OF THE ASSOCIATION OF METIS AND NON-STATUS INDIANS HAS BEEN NEGOTIATING WITH THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ON THE TRANSFER OF THE LEXRETT METIS FARM.

YOU HAVE A PROPOSAL WHICH DETAILS THE PROPOSED USE AND OPERATION AND ACTIVITY OF THE LERETT METIS FARM DATED OCTOBER 15/1982. ALSO YOU HAVE THE PRESENTATION WHICH DETAILS THE RATIONALLE FOR THE TRANSFER DATED SEPTEMBER 1981.

PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS NOTIFICATION OF OUR DESIRE TO EXPIDITE THIS MATTER AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE TO THE END THAT WE MIGHT IMPLIMENT THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN OUR PROPOSAL.

WE HAVE MET WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATIVE AFFAIRS AND WE ARE DETAILING AMMENDMENTS FOR CLARIFICATION TO OUR ORIGINAL PROPOSAL. THESE AMMENDMENTS WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNMENT DECEMBER 3/1982.

WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO THE FINALIZING OF THIS MATTER AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
