Beauchamp, Pierre. (1810-1862)

Pierre was born circa 1810, the son of Jean-Baptiste Beauchamp (1754-1788) and Josephte Daze (1761-1789). He married Marie Comtois dite Morin, circa 1831 She was the daughter of Etienne Comtois dit Morin and Marguerite (Sarcee). Pierre then married Scholastique Versailles in 1863 at St. Norbert. She was the daughter of Pierre Versailles and Josephte Letendre. His son Pierre Jr. signed Riel's petition for a Reserve in Montana.

Children of Pierre and Marie Comtois:

- Jerome, born September 14, 1883 at St. Boniface. He married Genevieve Parisien.
- Pierre, born before 1837, he married Nancy Ward.
- Marie, born 1837, she married Moise Goulet. Moise Goulet and his nephew Leonide Goulet were both members of the 49th Rangers, the Métis Scouts of the 1873-74 Boundary Commission.
- Abraham, born 1840 at St. Norbert, he married Marie Desjarlais.
- Josephte, born 1843 at St. Boniface, she married David Venne.
- Marie Anne, born 1846, she married Alexis Henry.
