Bousquet, Louis Jr. (1823-1859)

Louis was the Métis son of Louis and Marie Bousquet. He was orphaned at age four and placed under the guardianship of Bishop Provencher and attended the bishop's school in St. Boniface. He then became a teacher at the school. He was married to Betsy Fisher, the daughter of Chief Trader and later Councilor, Henry Munro Fisher and Marguerite Laframboise.

In 1851, Bousquet was appointed as a Judge of the petty court of the Upper District of Assiniboia. In 1856, he was appointed to take the census in his district. The Sioux murdered him on August 16, 1858.

Henri, born circa 1845 at Red River. He married Marie Marguerite Wilkie. Julienne, born June 7, 1847 at St. Boniface. She married William Boyer. Elizabeth, born May 29, 1849. She married Jean Baptiste Boyer². Elise, born March 16, 1852 at St. Boniface. She married Isidore Gaudry. Marguerite, born 1853. She married Moise Racette. Chrysostome, born circa 1855. He married Rose-Marie Carriere. Domtilde, born May 9, 1858 at St. Boniface. She married Isidore Zace.
